FEB 5, Thursday DEPART CANADA / AMSTERDAM

Tour members from across Canada gather to fly to Amsterdam before connecting to South Africa.

FEB 6, Friday AMSTERDAM / CAPE TOWN

After our late arrival in Cape Town, we will be transferred directly to our hotel in vibrant Bantry Bay on the slopes of Lion’s Head. **The President Hotel** (3 nights)

FEB 7, Saturday CAPE TOWN

Our day begins with a cable car ride up Table Mountain (weather permitting). This unique landmark rises over 1,000 metres above the city and spreads horizontally across the skyline. Following lunch at the waterfront, enjoy some leisure time exploring. BL

FEB 8, Sunday CAPE PENINSULA

Enjoy a guided walk through the Kirstenbosch National Botanical Garden, a 528-hectare natural area set on the slopes of Table Mountain with over 10,000 different native flowers and plants. Following a lunch break, we will visit the

penguin colony at Boulders Beach. Delight in the magnificent scenery as we drive to Cape Point, at the tip of the Cape of Good Hope. Cap off the day with a delightful welcome dinner at a local restaurant. BD

FEB 9, Monday

STELLENBOSCH / FRANSCHHOEK / MONTAGU

This morning we depart for the long-established university town of Stellenbosch, with its oak-lined streets and stately mansions. The area was first settled in 1680, and many buildings here date from the late 18th century. Continue to a local wine estate for a cellar tour, wine tasting and lunch. Explore Franschhoek, situated in a beautiful valley of its own, where we shall see the Huguenot Monument before we continue to Montagu.

FEB 10, Tuesday

LITTLE KAROO / OUDTSHOORN

Our journey east follows the route of the early settlers over rolling farmlands and past spectacular scenery. Our travels will take us through Barrydale into the Little Karoo. Following lunch, we continue to De Krans Estate where we will enjoy a glass of port wine. We then head to our hotel in the historic town of Oudtshoorn, made wealthy by ostrich feather trading.

FEB 11, Wednesday

OUDTSHOORN / GARDEN ROUTE

This morning we shall explore the fascinating Cango Caves followed by a visit to an ostrich farm to learn more about these fascinating birds and to enjoy a lunch featuring its eggs and very lean meat. This afternoon we descend the Outeniqua Pass and drive through the Garden Route Lakes District to the resort centre of Knysna.

FEB 12, Thursday

GARDEN ROUTE

Enjoy a leisurely morning or take an optional cruise on the Knysna Lagoon. In the afternoon, visit Theodora Crèche for a community-hosted reception, followed by a stop at Birds of Eden. Later, take a walk in Robberg Nature Reserve and enjoy a glass of bubbly. End the day with dinner on the Knysna Waterfront. BD

FEB 13, Friday

PORT ELIZABETH / UMHLANGA

Departing early, we head east along the coast, following the scenic route from Tsitsikamma to Port Elizabeth, a city known for its sunshine and relaxed coastal vibe. From there, we fly to Durban and spend the night near the city's northern shoreline.

FEB 14, Saturday

DURBAN / ZULULAND

Start the day with a panoramic city tour of Durban before continuing to St Lucia, known for its birdlife. Take a boat cruise through the wetlands before heading into Zulu country to check in to our delightful inn.

FEB 15, Sunday

MKUZE GAME RESERVE

This morning we are taken on our first game drive, exploring the Mkuze Game Reserve in open 4x4 vehicles, with opportunities to see a wide variety of game. This afternoon we can relax at our resort or join an optional

excursion to explore the mountainous countryside of the traditional Zulu homelands, highlighted by a visit to a Zulu compound where we will be introduced to their unique lifestyle. Weather permitting, the evening includes a BBQ dinner and a presentation of Zulu war dances. BD

FEB 16, Monday

SWAZILAND

This morning, we cross into neighbouring Eswatini, an independent kingdom. Take a scenic drive through the countryside with a stop at a local roadside market, before continuing to the Ezulwini Valley for lunch.

FEB 17, Tuesday

KRUGER NATIONAL PARK

Take in the spectacular scenery as we drive over Piggs Peak and enter eastern Mpumalanga en route to Kruger National Park. Later, look out for wildlife as we cross the park by coach. **Perry Bridge Hollow** (2 nights) BD

FEB 18, Wednesday

KRUGER NATIONAL PARK

Enjoy a full day game drive through the heart of Kruger National Park in open game-viewing vehicles. Keep an eye out for sightings of the "Big Five" which includes elephants, buffalos, rhinos, lions and leopards. This evening, relax in our delightful lodge. BD

FEB 19, Thursday

BLYDE RIVER CANYON / NELSPRUIT

Set off on a scenic drive from the plains of Kruger to the Highveld. Following its crest, we'll enjoy magnificent views of Blyde River Canyon and God's Window. Take in the stunning scenery along the escarpment before continuing to our hotel. **Protea Nelspruit Hotel** (1 night) BD

FEB 20, Friday

PRETORIA / ROSEBANK

Today we travel to Pretoria crossing the rolling farmlands of the Highveld. Pretoria is the picturesque administrative capital of South Africa. Explore this gracious city known for its broad avenues bordered by flowering trees and its impressive public buildings and monuments.

FEB 21, Saturday

JOHANNESBURG / SOWETO

Drive through Johannesburg, a city created from the wealth of gold and diamonds, before a visit to the engaging Apartheid Museum. We enjoy a special lunch at Chez Alina before heading off to explore the township of Soweto, home of Bishop Desmond Tutu and Nelson Mandela. BL

FEB 22, Sunday

SOWETO / VICTORIA FALLS, ZIMBABWE

Our flight today brings us to Victoria Falls, the largest waterfall in Africa at 108 metres high and nearly 1.7 kilometres wide. Discovered by David Livingstone in 1855, the falls are the region's most spectacular natural sight. Take a guided walk with views of the Main Falls, Devil's Cataract, and Danger Point. Weather permitting, an optional helicopter ride offers a different perspective from above. **Ilala Lodge** (1 night) BD

FEB 23, Monday

CHOBE, BOTSWANA

This morning we drive across the border and into the north of Botswana and the gateway to Chobe National Park. Home to superb game viewing, Chobe covers over 11,000 sq. kilometres and has a large variety of wildlife including large herds of buffalo and elephant plus hippos and lions. Enjoy free time to relax by the pool and appreciate a dinner under the stars accompanied by the unique sounds of Africa. **Chobe Game Lodge** (3 nights) BLD

FEB 24, Tuesday

CHOBE

Enjoy a full day in the park with morning and afternoon excursions in open land rovers and by boat to view the game that frequent the fertile flood plains of the Zambezi. A highlight of our stay will be the visit by boat to a natural hippo pool, a short distance from the lodge. BLD

FEB 25, Wednesday

CHOBE

We continue our exploration of Chobe's spectacular landscape with another day dedicated to discovering its rich wildlife and pristine ecosystems. BLD

FEB 26, Thursday

KASANE / JOHANNESBURG / CANADA

Relax and enjoy the amenities of our beautiful resort or join an early morning game drive before checking out after breakfast. Later today we catch our return flights from Kasane to Canada via Johannesburg. B

FEB 27, Friday

JOHANNESBURG / CANADA

On arrival in Toronto, we catch our continuing flights to our homes across Canada.
