ICONIC NATURAL WONDERS

Experience Iceland's stunning landscapes, from the floating icebergs of Jökulsárlón Glacier Lagoon and the thundering Gullfoss and Dettifoss waterfalls to the black sand beaches, glaciers and volcanic scenery of the South Coast.

VOLCANIC ICELAND

Relax in the Blue Lagoon, explore the ancient Raufarhólshellir lava tunnel, discover the bubbling geothermal fields of Hverir, and witness real molten lava during Reykjavík's spectacular Icelandic Lava Show.

Cruise from Húsavík in search of whales, visit Ytri Tunga's grey seal colony, meet Icelandic horses on a family farm, and explore dramatic coastal villages, basalt cliffs and iconic Kirkjufell Mountain.

Discover Iceland's rich history at Viking World and a recreated Viking Village, explore traditional turf houses at Glaumbær, sample fermented shark, and learn how life has been shaped by fire and ice.

CHALLENGING:

This is a coach tour with some long travel days and a busy itinerary. Several site visits involve walking over rough, uneven surfaces, so members should be good walkers to fully enjoy the journey. Hotels in Iceland are clean and comfortable, with compact rooms reflecting the island's simple lifestyle. Most are two stories and do not have elevators. As porters are not available, members must handle their own luggage. Iceland is an expensive destination, and while this tour offers exceptional value, members should budget for the high cost of additional meals and services.

ITINERARY

JUN 1 | CANADA / KEFLAVÍK

Tour members from across Canada gather for our overnight flight to Iceland.

JUN 2 | BLUE LAGOON / LAVA CAVE / HVOLSVOLLUR

Welcome to Iceland! Our journey begins at Viking World, where we enjoy breakfast surrounded by Viking history. We unwind in the famous Blue Lagoon, soaking in its warm geothermal waters before exploring the remarkable Raufarhólshellir lava tunnel. Formed more than 5,000 years ago, this fascinating cave reveals the path of ancient lava flows that shaped Iceland's volcanic landscape.

Hotel Loa - 1 night (BD)

JUN 3 | SOUTH COAST / VÍK / HNAPPAVELLIR

Today we discover Iceland's spectacular south coast. Walk behind the cascading Seljalandsfoss waterfall, admire the powerful Skógafoss, and visit the dramatic black sand beach of Reynisfjara with its towering basalt columns. We also stop in the charming village of Vík í Mýrdal, Iceland's southernmost coastal community.

Fosshótel Glacier Lagoon Hotel - 2 nights (BD)

JUN 4 | JOKULSARLON & SKAFTAFELL NP

An unforgettable day awaits at Jökulsárlón Glacier Lagoon, where we cruise among floating icebergs on an amphibian boat tour. Nearby, Diamond Beach sparkles with ice resting on black volcanic sand. We continue to Svínafellsjökull glacier before exploring beautiful Skaftafell National Park, known for its glaciers, rugged mountains and dramatic scenery. (BD)

JUN 5 | VATNAJÖKULL NP / EASTFJORDS

Step back into Iceland's Viking past with a visit to a recreated Viking Village before travelling along the breathtaking southeast coast. We stop at Vestrahorn Mountain and nearby Stokksnes, one of Iceland's most photographed landscapes. Scenic stops along the way include Berufjörður Fjord, Beljandi Waterfall and the seaside village of Breiðdalsvík.

Fosshotel Eastfjords - 1 night (BD)

JUN 6 | EASTFJORDS / MYVATN

Experience the geothermal wonders of Hverir, where bubbling mud pools, steaming vents and colourful mineral deposits create an unforgettable landscape. Later, enjoy a walk through the extraordinary lava formations and caves of Dimmuborgir, one of Iceland's most unusual natural attractions.

Fosshotel Myvatn - 2 nights (BD)

JUN 7 | DIAMOND CIRCLE & WHALE WATCHING

Travel to the charming harbour town of Húsavík, Iceland's whale-watching capital, for a memorable cruise in search of whales in their natural habitat. We then visit mighty Dettifoss, one of Europe's most powerful waterfalls, before exploring Ásbyrgi Canyon, a horseshoe-shaped valley steeped in Icelandic legend. (BD)

JUN 8 | NORTH ICELAND

Visit Goðafoss, the beautiful Waterfall of the Gods, before stopping at a family farm to enjoy an Icelandic horse demonstration and a traditional soup lunch. This afternoon

we explore the preserved turf houses at Glaumbær, offering a fascinating glimpse into Iceland's rural life through the centuries.

Fosshótel Stykkishólmur - 1 night (BLD)

JUN 9 | SNÆFELLSNES PENINSULA

Today we explore the spectacular Snæfellsnes Peninsula, often called "Iceland in Miniature" for its remarkable variety of landscapes. Visit the black sand cove of Djúpalónssandur, the picturesque fishing village of Arnarstapi and the iconic Kirkjufell Mountain with its beautiful waterfall. Learn about Iceland's unique food traditions at the Shark Museum, including a tasting of fermented shark, before visiting the striking black church of Búðakirkja and the seal colony at Ytri Tunga.

Hotel Vesturland - 1 night (BD)

JUN 10 | BORGANES / REYKJAVÍK

Arrive in Reykjavík, the world's northernmost capital, for a panoramic city tour featuring Hallgrímskirkja and Harpa Concert Hall. Experience the spectacular Icelandic Lava Show, where real molten lava is poured before your eyes, then visit the award-winning Perlan Museum to discover Iceland's glaciers, ice caves and the Northern Lights through immersive exhibits.

Reykjavík Marina - Berjaya Iceland Hotels - 2 nights (B)

JUN 11 | GOLDEN CIRCLE

Explore Iceland's famous Golden Circle, beginning at Þingvellir National Park, where the world's oldest parliament was founded and the North American and Eurasian tectonic plates meet. Enjoy lunch at the Friðheimar Tomato Greenhouse before visiting the erupting Geysir geothermal area and the magnificent Gullfoss waterfall. This evening, celebrate our Icelandic adventure with a farewell dinner at Harpa Concert Hall. (BLD)

JUN 12 | DEPART REYKJAVÍK

Enjoy some free time before transferring to Keflavík International Airport for your return flight home.
