UNESCO & ANCIENT CITIES

Discover four UNESCO World Heritage sites: Fes' medieval medina, the Roman ruins of Volubilis, the Historic City of Meknes, home to the magnificent Bab Mansour gate, and Aït-Ben-Haddou, the earthen ksar that served as a backdrop for *Lawrence of Arabia*.

IMPERIAL HERITAGE

Admire Rabat's Mausoleum of Mohammed V, Marrakech's Ben Youssef Madrasa and Bahia Palace, and tour Casablanca's Hassan II Mosque, one of the world's largest.

DESERT & NATURAL WONDERS

Ride a camel across the Sahara dunes at sunset, explore the limestone cliffs of Todra Gorge and drive through the Valley of Roses to Skoura's ancient palm grove.

CULTURAL ENCOUNTERS

Discover Amazigh traditions in the Ourika Valley, meet nomadic communities in Khamlia, and learn the secrets of Moroccan cuisine during a hands-on cooking experience at La Maison Arabe. Wander through the ancient tanneries of Fes, where leather has been crafted for centuries, then follow the aromas of spices through the city's bustling souks.

ITINERARY

OCT 2 | DEPART CANADA

Tour members from across Canada gather in Toronto and Montreal for the overnight flight to Casablanca.

OCT 3 | CASABLANCA / RABAT

Welcome to Morocco! On arrival in Casablanca, meet our local guide and transfer to Rabat, stopping at the magnificent Hassan Tower, a 12th-century minaret, before settling into our hotel and gathering for dinner. *Conrad Rabat Arzana - 2 nights* (D)

OCT 4 | RABAT

Rabat welcomes us with a sea breeze and calm grandeur. Explore the Kasbah, Mausoleum of Mohammed V, Royal Palace and ancient Chellah ruins, followed by free time before dinner with the group. (BD)

OCT 5 | MEKNES / VOLUBILIS / FES

We travel to Fes, one of the world's oldest and largest medieval cities, stopping in Meknes to admire Bab Mansour and the Mausoleum of Moulay Ismail. After lunch, explore the Roman ruins of Volubilis, a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Barceló Fès Medina - 2 nights (BL)

OCT 6 | FES

At the heart of the Medina of Fes, skilled artisans shape brass and weave intricate textiles using centuries-old techniques. Narrow souk lanes lead us through a world filled with the scents of cedarwood, leather and warm spices. We'll wander bustling districts where tanners dye hides in vibrant vats, then admire the exteriors of Kairaouine Mosque and the Sultan's Palace before a peaceful walk through the botanical oasis of Bou Jeloud Gardens. (BD)

OCT 7 | FES / AGUELMAME SIDI ALI

After free time in Fes, we journey toward Merzouga, stopping in Ifrane, the Switzerland of Morocco, known for its alpine-style architecture and mountain setting. We then overnight in the Middle Atlas Mountains, with our lodge overlooking Lake Aguelmame Sidi Ali, a peaceful retreat before entering the Sahara the next day. *Xaluca Hotel Aguelmame Sidi Ali - 1 night* (BD)

OCT 8 | MIDDLE ATLAS MOUNTAINS / MERZOUGA

We drive through the scenic Ziz Valley to Erfoud, Morocco's fossil capital, where we visit a leading fossil cooperative to learn how ancient fossils are extracted and transformed into decorative pieces. Continuing to Merzouga, we switch to 4x4s for our journey into the Sahara and our desert camp, where dinner awaits beneath a star-filled sky.

Merzouga Luxury Desert Camp - 2 nights (BLD)

OCT 9 | MERZOUGA

We begin with a 4x4 excursion to the historic Kehel Mine and Khamlia Village, meeting local nomads and discovering their traditional way of life. Following lunch at our desert camp, enjoy a gentle camel ride across the dunes to watch the spectacular desert sunset. (BLD)

OCT 10 | MERZOUGA / SKOURA

We travel to historic Rissani, birthplace of the Alaouite Dynasty,

then continue through the dramatic Todra Gorge and Valley of Roses to the tranquil Skoura Palm Grove.

Ksar Elkabbaba - 2 nights (BLD)

OCT 11 | SKOURA

Historically known as the Oasis of a Thousand Palms, Skoura was a vital resting place along the ancient trans-Saharan trade routes. We delve into this sanctuary today, with a guided visit to the Kasbah Amridil, featured on Morocco's 50-dirham banknote. Exploring its intricate courtyards reveals centuries of traditional Moroccan life. The afternoon is ours to relax and enjoy the tranquil environment of this oasis. (BD)

OCT 12 | SKOURA / OURIKA

Travelling north through Ouarzazate, we reach Ait Benhaddou, a UNESCO World Heritage site, famous for its earthen clay architecture and the iconic backdrop for Lawrence of Arabia. After our visit, our drive ascends into the lush Ourika Valley.

Kasbah d'Ourika - 2 nights (BLD)

OCT 13 | OURIKA

The Amazigh (Berber) peoples are indigenous to North Africa and have deep roots in Morocco, with a history and culture that stretches back long before the arrival of Arabic, Roman or European influence. Today we will immerse ourselves in their world, spending the day exploring traditional Berber life. Our day begins with a gentle hike, before visiting a local argan cooperative, and sharing tea with a local family. (BLD)

OCT 14 | OURIKA / MARRAKECH

We make a short transfer to Marrakech, stopping for a visit at the Organic Aromatic Garden of Ourika, a peaceful showcase of Morocco's aromatic and medicinal plants. In Marrakech, we explore the lively Jemaa el-Fna and winding souks filled with craft and culture. *Riad Kniza - 3 nights* (BD)

OCT 15 | MARRAKECH

We will spend the day exploring the wonders of Marrakech. We will admire the exterior of the iconic Koutoubia Mosque, one of Marrakech's most important mosques, before stepping inside the beautifully decorated Ben Youssef Madrasa, formerly an Islamic college. We end our city tour with the elegant Bahia Palace, built in the 19th century. (BL)

OCT 16 | MARRAKECH

A culinary experience awaits us at La Maison Arabe, one of Marrakech's finest restaurants since 1946. Under the guidance of an expert chef, we will discover the secrets of Moroccan cuisine and prepare a selection of traditional dishes. The rest of the day is yours to enjoy. (BL)

OCT 17 | MARRAKECH / CASABLANCA

In Casablanca, visit the magnificent Hassan II Mosque overlooking the Atlantic, followed by city highlights and a farewell dinner. *Art Palace Suites & Spa - 1 night* (BD)

OCT 18 | HOMEWARD BOUND

Early this morning, we bid farewell to Morocco as we catch our flights home to Canada. (B)

The vibrant colours of Fes' tanneries begin with plants and spices. The giant honeycombed stone vats are traditionally filled with natural dyes, including poppy flowers for red, saffron or pomegranate for yellow, henna for orange, cedarwood for brown, and mint or indigo for green and blue.
